The agency provides an array of support services to individuals and their families in Southeastern Massachusetts and Cape Cod.

Our Access Centers act as a base to provide services and supports that reflect the wants, needs and requests of each member and his or her family.

We believe our members' services should not have to fit into a predetermined service or program agenda.

Our professional staff work with each individual to create a plan that fits each individual's vision for their own future. Through our commitment to listening and working together, support plans are developed to assist the individual in striving to achieve his or her personal goals.

Our Services

Habilitation Assistance is dedicated to improving the lives of all people of all abilities in relation to each individual's journey and specializes in the accommodating differences between people.

Our customers come to us with different backgrounds, i.e. intellectual issues, autism, brain injuries, and our staff are prepared to work with each individual, with their individual abilities and dreams, to make their lives better.

The agency offers a plethora of services and is not held to a strict guideline, but is eager to tailor each program to our customer's needs. We offer day habilitation, community based support, individual support, case management, supported living, home care assistance, and transportation services.

A variety of funding sources are available in addition to private payment. We are an approved provider working with MassHealth, Mass. Department of Developmental Disabilities, Mass. Commission for the Blind, Mass. Rehabilitation Commission as well as other local and governmental authorities. We are always available to discuss payment options available to you.

Day Habilitation

Day habilitation services and activities consist of planned, coordinated, goal-oriented supports that are designed to improve functional ability. The provision of clinical services such as occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech and language development therapy, activities of daily living while also providing nursing supervision, are designed to improve levels of independence and self satisfaction.

Development of an individualized day habilitation service plan by the member, his or her family or caregiver, and our clinical team is done and progress measured on an ongoing basis. The provision of our clinical services in an established therapeutic environment and supportive atmosphere facilitates taking risks and meeting challenges, thus encouraging our members towards optimal social functioning, skill development and personal growth.

Transportation

We recognize that transportation is often an integral part of one's life. Reliable transportation means an individual can be involved with community activities and can access necessary health care. To help fulfill this need, we developed Access Express, a safe, dependable and accessible transportation service.

We offer transportation to and from our Access Centers for day habilitation services on a daily basis through local transit authorities, CCRTA, GATRA and MART.

Funding support for transportation services by Access Express may be covered in a variety of ways due to our many licenses and certification by state and local municipalities. Quite often, 100% funding can be arranged. Call Access Express for more information.

Supported Living & Case Management Services

Supported living services enable consumers to live independently in the community. These consumers may have physical disabilities in combination with other sensory, emotional or cognitive limitations, and include youth who are transitioning from special education services into the community as well as adults over the age of 18 who need supports in order to leave institutional settings or continue to live in their own homes. These supports include assessment, supported living plan design, case coordination, and ancillary services.

Case management is available to persons in need of support in assessing care needs, arranging services, hiring and managing caretakers and adjusting care plans and services as needed.

We offer supported living and case management services through the Massachusetts Rehabilitation Commission, Statewide Head Injury Program, Acquired Brain Injury Program, Money Follows the Person, and Agency with Choice.

Alternative Services

The agency offers a variety of alternative services to fit the individual need or interest of a specific customer. Supports such as adult companion, homemaker, individual supports and community habilitation, personal care, supportive home care aide, recreational activities, in-home instruction and community involvement are offered through this service area.

Alternative services are provided in an outreach model and can include all of the clinical services available through our Resource Team of consultants in the fields of Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy, Speech/Language Therapy, Health Care/ Nursing and Behavior Therapy.
